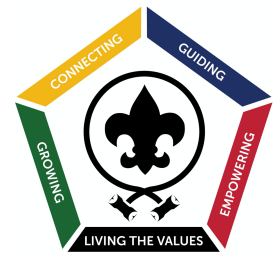

## Included with Course Fee

- WB138 short sleeve activity tee shirt
- WB138 hat
- WB138 backpack, nametag & luggage tags
- WB138 water bottle
- All food
- Notebook
- Amazing program & loads of fun

## Required Personal Gear

- Full official BSA field uniform (note 1)
- Activity uniform (note 2)
- Underwear & socks (1 crazy pair), 1 week supply
- Shoes or boots appropriate for hiking (note 3)
- Sleepwear
- Jacket or windbreaker (cool evenings)
- Rain gear
- Unscented toiletries, hand sanitizer (note 3)
- Towel & washcloth
- Backpack suitable for camping 2 days/nights
- Sleeping bag and pillow (tents & cots provided)
- Headlamp or flashlight w/spare batteries
- Folding camp chair, no loungers (note 3)
- Water bottle, second 32oz Nalgene (note 3)
- Mess kit & dunk / drying bag
- Cup or mug (plastic or metal, no glass)
- Pens / pencils for note taking

## Suggested Personal Gear

- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen, lip balm, insect repellent
- Extra shoes / camp slippers (no open toe shoes)
- Waterproof wristwatch
- Pocketknife or multi-tool
- Portable charger, outlet adapter (3 plug max)
- Personal medication in labeled bottles
- Books – religious & Scouting skits / songs
- Bandana, hair ties, headband, handkerchief
- Carabiners
- Microfiber cloth (cleaning glasses, sunglasses)
- Ziploc bags, gallon size (note 3)

## Required Group Gear (note 4)

- Lightweight backpacking stove & fuel
- Spice kit

## Electronic Device Policy

Electronic devices are prohibited during the course. Phones must be off or silenced. Calls are only allowed during personal free time. Wi-Fi is available at the Philmont Training Center (PTC). Your PTC tent has electricity, but there is no outlet in your backcountry tent.

## Notes

- 1) An official field uniform is the uniform of your current Scouting position. It includes the official BSA shirt, shoulder loops, BSA shorts, long/short pants or skirt, BSA socks and BSA leather or web belt. **Please do not wear white activity socks.**
- 2) An activity uniform is the same as your field uniform except you will wear the WB138 activity tee shirt. Additional short and long sleeve activity shirts are available for purchase. It is recommended that at least one additional shirt be purchased.
- 3) We spend time in the backcountry. Safety is #1; bears may be near. "Smellables" must be stored in Philmont bear boxes. Ziploc bags hold smellables. Two water bottles allow one for water only. There are a few short (<60 minutes) hikes. Crocs or slip-on are NOT recommended. Comfortable shoes at PTC. If traveling by air, ask us to bring a camp chair for you.
- 4) If you have these, please bring them. Don't buy them just for the course. We need some participants to provide this gear.
